## Directions

**Coastguard Cottage: 61 Fore Street, Port Isaac, Cornwall, PL29 3RE**

Please telephone us for information on the location of the key.

FROM BRISTOL: On the M5 Southbound towards Exeter. At Exeter get on to the A30 signed Oakhampton. (Port Isaac is about 70 miles from Exeter and should take approximately 1hour 15 minutes from here.)

Stay on the A30 until you pass Launceston. After a further 2 miles turn off the A30 onto the A395 towards North Cornwall. After approximately 12 miles you will arrive at the T-junction with the A39; turn left. After a further 1 mile on the A39 turn right onto the B3314, signed North Cornwall Tintagel. At the slightly offset crossroads go straight over (staying on the B3314). You should go straight through Delabole and then through Pendoggett. Approximately a mile after Pendoggett take the 1st right turn signed Port Isaac on the B3267.

In Port Isaac stay on the main road you will pass the CRS/Co-Op which will be on your right, then just before you get to a sharp right hand bend take the turning on the left, signed to the Harbour, this is Back Hill. At the bottom of Back Hill at the T Junction you will be facing the Old School Hotel; turn right into Fore Street. You should then pass a narrow turning on the left hand side signed The Cliff Path, after a further 30m there is another small turning on the left just as the road goes sharply to the right. Take this turning, when the road forks after a further 10m go left into a large courtyard. 61 Fore Street is the on the right hand side second to the end.

Please park next to the **Black Garage Door** at the end of the courtyard on the left, leaving space for another car to park next to "The Lookout".

Should you have any problems or concerns during your stay please contact us on 01458 251152 or 07970 111401.

There are several good Public Houses in the Village. Our favourite is the Golden Lion, which serves good reasonable priced food and has a balcony over looking the Harbour, the Crows nest and The Edge (Non Smoking Bar / Restaurant) are also very popular with excellent views out to sea and Tintagel Head. There are several excellent fish restaurants in the bottom of the village, the Slipway Hotel is the most popular but the Harbour Cafe is also worth visiting.
